Marine bioactive research finding

A newly-discovered bacterial symbiont of the green alga Bryopsis pennata is the source of kahalalide F, a bioactive originally isolated over 10 years ago from the seaslug Aplysia rufescens and developed by PharmaMar (Spain) for anticancer purposes. Kahalalide F is accumulated by Aplysia after grazing on Bryopsis and allows the seaslug to resist predation: ©Zan J et al <u>https://science.sciencemag.org/content/364/6445/eaaw6732</u>
